



Verily I say unto thee,
Today shalt thou be with me
 in **paradise.**" (Luke 23:42-43)

"**But now** they desire a better country, that is, an heavenly: wherefore God is not ashamed to be called their God: for he hath prepared for them a city." (Heb. 11:16)

Jesus comforted his followers and assured them of his plans.

"**Let not** your heart be troubled: ye believe in God believe also in me. In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go to prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also ... I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me." (John 14:1-3)

The book of Revelation assures us that a blessing will be received by those who read, hear, and keep the things written therein.

Chapters 21 and 22 of Revelation contain some of "those things," which God has prepared for those who love him.

"Blessed is he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein: For the time is at hand." (Rev. 1:3)

"**I saw a New Heaven** and **a New Earth**: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away ... there was **no more Sea** ... I John saw the **Holy City, New Jerusalem**, coming down from God out of heaven, as a bride adorned for her husband ... I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, **The Tabernacle of God** is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God.

And God, shall **Wipe Away All Tears** from their eyes; and there shall be **no More Death** ... **Sorrow** ... **Crying**, **neither** ... **any More Pain** for the former things, are passed away ... he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make **all Things New** ... Write, for these words are true and faithful ... he said unto me, It, is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning, and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of **The Fountain of The Water of Life Freely**. He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and **I will be his God, and he shall be my Son** ... And there came unto me one of the seven angels ... saying, Come, hither, I will shew thee the bride, the Lamb's wife. And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem. Descending out of heaven from God ... And I saw no temple therein: for **The Lord God Almighty and The Lamb are The Temple** of it. And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for **The Glory of God did Lighten it, and The Lamb is the Light thereof**. And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honour into it. And the gates of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be **no Night** there. And they shall bring the glory and honour of the nations into it. And there shall in **no Wise Enter into it anything that Defileth, neither whatsoever Worketh abomination, or Maketh a Lie: but they which are Written in the Lamb's book of life.**" (Rev. 21:1-7, 9-11, 22-27)

"**And he** shewed me a **Pure River of Water of Life**, clear as crystal, proceeding out of **The Throne of God and of The Lamb**. In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there **The Tree of Life**, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the **Healing of The Nations**. "**And there shall be no More Curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him: And they shall see his face;**

and **his name shall be in their foreheads**. And there shall be **no Night** there; and they need no candle, neither light of the sun' for **the Lord God giveth them light: and they shall reign for ever and ever ... Blessed** are they that do his Commandments, that they may have right to **The Tree of Life and may enter in through the Gates into the City.**

For without are dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loveth and maketh a lie.

"**I Jesus** have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star. And the Spirit and the bride say, **Come**. And let him that heareth say, **Come**. And let Him that is athirst **Come**. And **whosoever will**, let him **take the Water of Life Freely** ... The Grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen." (Rev. 22:1-6,14-17, 21)

"**And this** is his commandment, that, we should believe on the name of his son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment. And he that keepeth his commandments dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the **Spirit** which he hath given us." (1 John 3:23)

Apostle Paul Preaches Jesus and the Spirit

"**And I**, brethren, when I came to you, came not with excellency of speech or of wisdom, declaring unto you the testimony of God.

For I determined not to know any thing among you, **save Jesus Christ, and him crucified.**

"**And I** was with you in weakness, and in fear, and in much trembling. And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:

That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.

“Howbeit we speak wisdom among them that are perfect:

Yet not the wisdom of this world, nor of the princes of this world, that come to nought:

“But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory:

“Which none of the princes of this world knew:

For had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

“But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.

But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.

“For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him?

Even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.

“Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God.

That we might know the things that are **freely given** to us of God.” (1 Cor. 2:1–12)

“And you hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins. Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience: Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others.

“But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us, even when we were

dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are **saved**;)

And hath raised us up together and made us **sit together** in heavenly places **in Christ Jesus**:

“Today you can be seated in Christ.

“That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us **through** ¹ **Christ Jesus**. For by grace are ye **saved through** ² **faith**; and that not of yourselves: it is the **gift of God**: Not of works, lest any man should boast—But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh

by the blood of Christ.

“For he is our peace, who hath made both one— And that he might reconcile both (Jew and Gentile) unto God in one body

by the cross,

“Having slain the enmity thereby: And came and preached peace to you (Gentiles) which were afar off, and to them (Jews) that were nigh. For through him we both have access

by one Spirit unto the Father.

“Now therefore **ye are no more strangers** and foreigners, but fellowcitizens (Jew and Gentile) with the saints, and of the household of God; And are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone; In whom all the building fitly framed together groweth unto an holy temple in the Lord: In whom **ye also** are builded together for an habitation of God

through the ³ **Spirit.”**
(Eph. 2:1–9, 13–14, 16–22)
